No. of participants : 1
Time duration : 2 min.

Instructions

- Any action song can be selected.
- Costume, accessories and props are strictly not allowed.

- Overall presentation



ACTION SONG MALAYALAM (LKG)

No. of participants : 1
Time duration : 2 min.

Instructions

- Any malayalam action song can be selected.
- Costume, accessories and props are strictly not allowed.

- Voice modulation
- Clarity & Pronunciation
- Rhythm
- Overall presentation



COLOURING WITH CRAYONS (LKG)

No. of participants : 3
Time duration : 1 hr.

Instructions

- An outline of a picture will be given.
- Only wax crayons/oil pastels can be used.
- Participating children have to bring wax crayons/oil pastels.

Criteria

- Neatness
- Even stroke
- Colour concept



CLAY MODELLING (UKG)

No. of participants : 2
Time duration : 1 hr.

Instructions

- A model of an object will be shown. Participants should make the exact replica of the given model.
- Each participant should bring 200gms each of any two colours of clay (plasticine).
- Using accessories, extra objects or any tools will not be permitted.

- Neatness
- Perfection
- Originality to the object shown
- Creativity



STORY TELLING MALAYALAM (UKG)

No. of participants : 1
Time duration : 3 min.

Instructions

- Any story with a moral can be selected.
- Costume, accessories and props are strictly not allowed.

Criteria

- Pronunciation
- Fluency
- Expression
- Voice modulation
- Action



BRAIN GYM (UKG)

No. of participants : 3
Time duration : 2 hrs.

Instructions

- The images will be projected on the screen for one minute.
- Circle the maximum images shown on screen in the worksheet provided.
- The participant who circles all the images without errors, will be declared the winner.



COLLAGE (UKG)

No. of participants : 2
Time duration : 1 hr 30min.

Instructions

- Outline of a picture and strips of coloured paper will be given.
- Participants should tear the strips of paper into small pieces and affix in the given picture.
- Participants should bring fevistick or gum.

- Colour concept



COLOURING WITH CRAYONS (UKG)

No. of participants : 3
Time duration : 1 hr.

Instructions

- An outline of a picture will be given.
- Only wax crayons/oil pastels can be used.

DRAWING AND COLOURING (UKG)

No. of participants : 3
Time duration : 1 hr.

Instructions

- Drawing paper of size 35cmx28cm (1/4th of a Chart Paper) will be provided.
- Participating children will have to bring crayons, pencils & erasers.
- Only wax crayons/oil pastels can be used. No other colouring medium or drawing materials should be used.
- Any picture can be drawn and coloured.

- Neatness
- Even stroke
- Colour concept



NANO OLYMPIAD (UKG)

No. of participants : 2
Time duration : 3 hrs.

Instructions

- Participants to complete four tasks.

Eg: Sorting, balancing, puzzles etc...

- Participants can go to the subsequent task only after the completion of previous task within the allotted time.
- The winner will be decided based on the ability to finish all four tasks in the stipulated time.

Criteria

- Speed
- Accuracy



ORIGAMI (UKG)

No. of participants : 2
Time duration : 45 min.

Instructions

- 15cmx15cm origami paper(craft paper – both sides same colour) will be provided.
- Participants can make only one object using any one coloured paper.
- Accessories are not allowed.
- Colours provided: Dark Pink, Orange, Green, Black and Yellow.
- Participants will not be allowed to carry anything to the venue.

SRUTHILAYAM SINGING MALAYALAM (UKG)

No. of participants : 1
Time duration : 3 min.

Instructions

- Any Malayalam song other than nursery rhymes and poems can be sung.
- Using karaoke is strictly not allowed.

- Pitching
- Rhythm
- Performance
- Modulation



SYMPHONY SINGING ENGLISH (UKG)

No. of participants : 1
Time duration : 3 min.

Instructions

- Any English song other than nursery rhymes can be sung.
- Using karaoke is strictly not allowed.

DANCE TO THE TUNE (LKG & UKG)

No. of participants : 3
Time duration : 1 hr.

Instructions

- Participants will have to dance to the music played on the spot.
- Props are not permitted.
- Any comfortable dress can be worn.
- Elimination round will be there.
- Can select either from LKG or UKG or can send from both.

Criteria

- Ability to dance.
- Rhythm.
- Overall presentation



THEATRE WORKSHOP (UKG)

No. of participants : 2
Time duration : 3 hrs.

Instructions

- It is an impromptu event.
- Three best performers will be selected.
- Any comfortable dress can be worn.
- Send children who are talented in drama and dance.



GENERAL RULES

- A student can take part only in one event as all the events start at the same time.
- Judges decision will be final and binding.
- Participants should not appear in their school uniform.
- Entry to the events will be limited to the LKG (age : 4 to 5) and UKG (age : 5 to 6) students of each school.
- If participants do not report on time to the venue, they will be disqualified.
- The first 60 participants only will be accommodated for the workshop.
- School property is to be well taken care of. Our campus is a plastic-free zone. Hence avoid plastics.
- Lunch and snacks can be bought from the food stalls.
- A very light refreshment will be provided to all the participants free of cost.

REGISTRATION

- Registration should be done online at www.rajagiri.ac.in which will be open on **14th October 2024**, Monday onwards.
- Last date of registration will be **21st October 2024**, Monday.
- Any change in the name of participants should be done online itself on or before 24th October 2024, Thursday. No change of names will be entertained after that.
- Please note, there won't be any spot registration or registration over the phone.
- Registration must be done by the school itself for the entire participants. (Not by parents/individual participant).
- Even if registered online, a teacher or parent representative must report at the registration counter at Rajagiri Public School main building on Saturday, 09th November 2024 at 08:00 am. to complete the formalities.
- Registration fee of Rs.50/- for each participant should be paid online during the registration.
- For the theatre workshop registration fee is Rs.100/- per head.
- Participating schools can contact the school office between 09:00 am and 03:00 pm on any working day for clarification.

PRIZES

- First, Second and Third prizes will be awarded for each competitive event.
 - Points will be awarded as follows:
 - I - 15 points
 - II - 10 points
 - III - 5 points
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- The school that participates for all the events will get an additional 5 points.
 - All participants will be given a bag full of gifts and a participation certificate.
 - The school adjudged overall winner and runner up in the competition will be awarded rolling trophies.
 - Prize distribution will be held at 03:30 pm during the Valedictory function on the same day.
